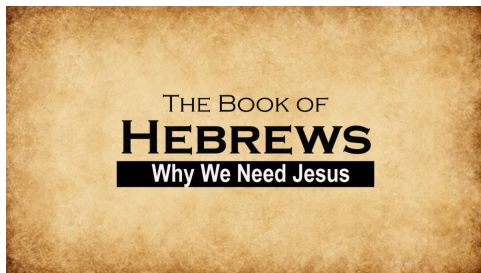

Why did Jesus enter the picture? Wasn't God good enough? Prior to Jesus, worshiping God meant a lot of sacrifice in the temple just to be sure that God knew of our love. In this first of a three week Hebrews series, this short passage succinctly answers the question of why we need Jesus and forms the basis of Christianity.

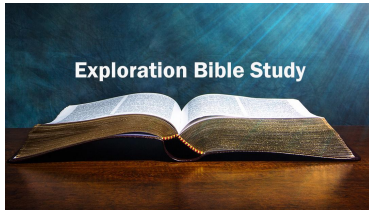
