Adult Mission Opportunity

On May 27, 2019, a devastating EF4 tornado went through Dayton, Ohio, damaging thousands of homes in the area. The denominational Week of Compassion office is now working with a Recovery Operations Group in the Miami Valley to help families displaced from tornado-damaged rental housing. Their goal is to help make these families first-time homeowners.

Geist Christian is going to help by forming a team of volunteers (up to 9 people, age 14 or older) to assist in finishing the interiors of some of these houses.
